The Alverno College Physician Assistant (PA) Program is currently reviewing applications for a full time PA Clinical Coordinator/Faculty. Alverno College is delineated as an Applicant Program to the Accreditation Review Commissions on Education for the Physician Assistant (ARC-PA).

A review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.

This is a full time exempt faculty position with specific administrative responsibilities as essential components of employment. Salary and academic rank will be commensurate with qualifications, education, and experience. Alverno College health, disability, and retirement plan enrollment is available to full time employees and eligible dependents. Tuition benefits are available for employees and qualified dependents.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Participation in all aspects of the development and coordination of the clinical phase of the PA program
- Ensures compliance with educational objectives of the clinical phase of the program
- Works closely with clinical preceptors and clinical site directors in facilitating PA student clinical experiences
- Ongoing sustainability and development of the clinical portion of the PA program
- Participation in ongoing program evaluation and planning
- Assist with fulfillment and maintenance of accreditation requirements
- Coordinate and participate in End of Rotation activities and testing
- Maintain and review scheduling of TYPHON logs
- Preparing, delivering instruction and assessing student performance in all phases of the PA program



- Participate in student advising, student admissions, and departmental committees as well as engagement in scholarship and service activities
- Maintain clinical practice hours

Qualifications and Education

- Graduate of an accredited PA program or other accredited college/university with a Master's degree or higher
- Current NCCPA certification
- Current Wisconsin PA license
- Minimum of 3 years clinical experience as a PA and experience in PA education is preferred
- Excellent communication and organization skills
