The College is seeking applicants for a full-time Head Softball Coach position for the Athletics department located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

Other duties and responsibilities may be assigned as necessary.*

Teach student-athletes sport techniques, game management and strategies, teamwork, leadership, sportsmanship, importance of proper nutrition and strength & conditioning methods. Develop players' skill level and increase their knowledge of the sport by implementing effective practice plans.

- Meet with player individually and/or as a team for self-assessment.
- Must be able to communicate effectively.
- Organize and operate an effective program based on integrity and focused on student-athlete welfare.
- Assure that the athletic activities are conducted in accordance with Alverno College, Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference and NCAA policies.
- Attend and plan all practices, competitions, and events for assigned sport
- Evaluate talent, contact prospects, and recruit new student-athletes to Alverno College in collaboration with Admissions.
- Coordinate travel and meal arrangements as well as safely transport athletes to and from all practices and competitions.
- Maintain inventory of equipment, uniforms, and supplies and purchase equipment if necessary.
- Assign duties and supervise assistant coach.

Qualifications

- Significant experience organizing and supervising a sports program is required.
- Requires previous teaching/coaching and/or playing experience in assigned sport to indicate substantial knowledge of technical aspects of the sport including knowledge and NCAA regulations.
- Strong communication skills with faculty, staff, students, coaches, officials and the general public.



- Demonstrated leadership abilities and an understanding of student development, in including the ability to balance student needs and take on an institutional perspective.
- Requires the ability to work in a team setting and work effectively with a variety of audiences and departments.
- Requires strong organization skills and the ability to multi-task and prioritize.
- Must be able to work evenings and weekends as necessary to attend practices and events.
- Must have a current driver's license and meet the qualifications of an Alverno driver.
- Ability to move freely, including the ability to frequently walk, stand, stoop and bend.
