The Master of Physician Assistant Studies (MPAS) Program at Alverno College is seeking applications for a 12-month, part time position as Medical Director. Alverno College is currently delineated as an Applicant Program to the Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant (ARC-PA).

A review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.

This is a part-time exempt faculty position with specific administrative responsibilities as essential components of employment. Salary and academic rank will be commensurate with qualifications, education, and experience. Alverno College health, disability, and retirement plan enrollment is available to full time employees and eligible dependents. Tuition benefits are available for employees and qualified dependents.

### **Primary Duties and Responsibilities**

The Medical Director supports the PA Program Director in current endeavors and demonstrates active involvement in providing instruction and evaluating student performance. The Medical Director will be involved in designing, implementing, coordinating and evaluating curriculum and evaluating the PA Program. The Medical Director facilitates establishment of clinical and professional relationships within the community and clinical institutions. S/he will be expected to attend program-related functions such as graduation, white coat ceremony, committee meetings, and activities vital to the program's success and continued accreditation. The Medical Director will meet regularly with PA faculty and staff to plan and evaluate activities, initiatives and curriculum.

Additional responsibilities may include teaching in areas of expertise, student evaluations, skills instruction, advising and remediation as necessary. Involvement in the student admissions and selection process along with assisting with accreditation preparation and maintenance are included in other responsibilities.



### **Qualifications and Education**

Previous experience in an academic setting or teaching position is strongly preferred. Successful candidates will have strong communication, interpersonal and problem-solving skills needed to foster PA students that are lifelong learners who will succeed academically and professionally to become leaders in the community and beyond. The ideal candidate will be knowledgeable and keep abreast of ongoing changes in the health care system.

- Currently licensed Wisconsin allopathic or osteopathic physician AND
- Currently certified by an ABMS- or AOA- approved specialty board.
- Experienced in working with physician assistants and knowledgeable of the PA role in providing quality patient care.
