

## How to Backup Courses in Moodle 2

Use the following procedure to back up the structure of a course in Moodle. The backup file will contain only the instructor created/uploaded information. **It does not include student information.** Any files students have uploaded, grades, quiz results, feedback or comments associated with student files, etc. will not be in the file.
