







## Directions for Connecting Macintosh OS X Computers to the Alverno College Network

Task	Screen Shot
1. From the <b>apple</b> menu select <b>System Preferences</b> .	
2. Once the preferences screen has come up double-click on the <b>Network</b> icon.	
3. After clicking on the network icon you will see a screen similar to the following: a. If the <b>lock</b> icon appears locked you will need to unlock it by clicking on the icon and typing in an administrator password. If you do not know your administrator password you may need to talk to the person who set up your computer. b. In the left column select <b>Ethernet</b> . c. Next to <b>Configure IPv4</b> select <b>Using DHCP</b> . d. Click on the <b>Apply</b> button and select quit from the system preferences menu.

<p>4. Under the <b>Go</b> menu select <b>Connect to Server</b>.</p>	
<p>5. You can connect to two different servers. You must type in the full path to the server on the <b>Server Address</b> line. The servers you can connect to are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. <b>smb://stu1srv.alverno.edu/Users</b> - This will open a folder from which you can navigate to your home folder</li><li>b. <b>smb://stu1srv.alverno.edu/courses</b> - This will open a folder which contains folder course-related information from faculty</li></ul>	
<p>6. You can save the path to any of these servers by clicking on the + button. You can then select the server from <b>Favorite Servers</b> instead of typing in the full address the next time you want to connect.</p>

<p>7. If you haven't already done so, click on the <b>Connect</b> button. You will be prompted for a username and password. The username and password are the same as the username and password you use to log on to other computers on campus.</p>
