






Installing Microsoft Lync 2013 on Campus PC's

Lync is a new Microsoft service that provides instant messaging, presence (Busy, Available, etc.), and audio and video conferencing with connections to Alverno users and off-campus users. For faculty and staff PC users on campus, Lync is available now! Please follow these instructions. Although you must have a Lync account to create meetings, anyone can join a Lync meeting using only a Web browser.
