### Tax Information Required for Students and Parents (if dependent)

  - Use the **IRS Data Retrieval Tool** by logging onto FAFSA at [fafsa.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov), select “*Make FAFSA Corrections*” and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. Follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the tool to transfer 2018 tax return data. **OR**

A transcript is usually sent to you within 10 calendar days.

  - Submit copies of your 2019 W-2 forms **and** IRS Verification of Non-Filing Letter. Follow the Verification of Non-filing instructions at <https://www.alverno.edu/Financial-Aid-Financial-Aid-Forms>. Once received by the IRS, the letter will be mailed to your address within 10 business days.
- If you are an independent student or parent and you did not work in 2019, you must:
  - Order an IRS Verification of Non-Filing Letter. Follow the instructions for requesting a Verification of Non-Filing Letter above.
