Principal Responsibilities

General

• Sets-up/restore, operate, and adapt patient care simulators, multimedia, computer and related equipment needed for health care simulations.

- Works in conjunction with CCE manager to oversee:
 - -Patient care simulation technologies and applications
 - -Lab preparation and maintence
 - -Standard computer software applications
 - -Assists, as needed, with simulation schedule
 - -Inventory and material storage and procedures
 - -Observe, document, and record simulation maintenance
 - -Completion of annual maintenance by vendors
- Operates patient care simulators, prepares simulation environment, and develops and applies scenario moulage to model physiological responses to the clinical and skill objectives and specifications.
- Problem solves new and existing patient care simulators and technology.
- Restores simulation environment to pre-scenario conditions.
- Provides recommendation for simulation improvements.
- Assists instructors with the implementation of clinical scenarios.
- Explains to students the functions of patient care simulators and related technology.
- Ensures student compliance with lab policies, procedures, and safety precautions.
- Performs and oversees maintenance and repair of simulators, and related technology in the simulation environment.
- Maintain appropriate records related to simulation maintenance and technologies.
- Supervises stocking of forms, supplies, materials, and equipment in the simulation environment; stores, discards, and rotates supplies and materials.
- Assists in the research of purchasing options for simulation equipment and software.

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- Participates in ongoing learning of new simulation technologies.
- Assist in maintenance of policy and procedure manuals for simulation.
- May be assigned to perform other duties in the CCE during peak workload periods and in the absence of assigned personnel.

- Collaborates with the simulation coordinator, facilitator and CCE manager to resolve issues related to patient care scenarios.
