

## **Guidelines for Video Auditions**

Applicants are strongly encouraged to audition in person so you may visit campus. If you are unable to attend a live audition, you have the option to audition via video. Guidelines are as follows:

- Video submissions must not be edited. Each selection must be performed beginning to end in one take.
- Introduce yourself at the beginning of the video. Introduce each selection by stating the composer's name and title of the composition, including movement if applicable.
- If your voice is not your primary instrument, choose a comfortable key and sing "Happy Birthday" in your video.
- Production effects (i.e., reverb, autotune, etc.) may not be used.
- Recordings must be made no more than 12 months prior to submission.
- Recordings must be in accordance with the audition repertoire guidelines.
- You may use the video/sharing platform that works best for you. If you choose a site such as YouTube or Vimeo, make sure the privacy settings allow us to view it with the link you send. You may also choose to upload a video to a file-sharing platform such as Google Drive or Dropbox. In either case, simply send us a link so we can access your video.

When you are ready to submit, email the audition coordinator and include a link to your video.
