


Logging into the Alverno Network

The Alverno network is your key to the campus computers. You need to log on to the network anytime you want to use an application, retrieve course work that is on the network, print, access the Internet and your email and to save files to your own home folder (H: drive).

If you have questions about your network account, come to the Computer Center open access lab, RC 109B.

Your user name consists of the first six letters of your last name, the first letter of your first name, and the first letter of your middle name. A sample user name for Susan B. Anthony would be **anthonsb**

<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. If the computer is turned on, move the mouse to "wake up" the computer;2. Type your User name;3. Type your Password;4. Click the arrow to the right of the password field or press Enter on the keyboard.

Your new password should:



- Be at least 8 characters long;
- Contain a combination of upper and lowercase letters;
- Include numbers;
- Not be the same as any of your last five (5) passwords;
- Passwords are cAsE-sensitive

Please note: For security reasons, there is a limit on the number of times you can attempt to log in with the wrong username and/or password before you are locked out. If there are three or more failed login attempts, the account will be locked for three minutes.

Logging off the Network

When you are finished using a computer on the Alverno network, **YOU MUST LOG OFF. If you do not log off, other users will be able to access your H: drive or use your account inappropriately.**

To Log off:

1. Click the **Start** button  in the lower-left corner of your screen.
2. Click the **User**  icon.
3. Click **Sign Out**.

Or

1. Double-click on the **Log Off PC** icon on the desktop.
