- Supports student learning and clinical skills validation activities in the CCE during open classroom sessions, open lab practice hours, clinical make-up sessions, and capstone projects.
- Sets-up/restores, operates, and adapts patient care simulators, multimedia, computer, and related equipment needed for health care simulations.
- Coordinates with Milwaukee-based colleagues as needed to support simulation.

- Operates patient care simulators, prepares simulation environment, and develops and applies scenario moulage to model physiological responses to the clinical and skill objectives and specifications.
- Problem solves new and existing patient care simulators and technology.
- Restores simulation environment to pre-scenario conditions.
- Provides recommendation for simulation improvements.
- Assists instructors with the implementation of clinical scenarios.
- Explains the functions of patient care simulators and related technology to students.
- Ensures student compliance with lab policies, procedures, and safety precautions.
- Performs and oversees maintenance and repair of simulators, and related technology in the simulation environment.
- Maintains appropriate records related to simulation maintenance and technologies.
- Supervises stocking of forms, supplies, materials, and equipment in the simulation environment; stores, discards, and rotates supplies and materials.
- Assists in the research of purchasing options for simulation equipment and software.
- Participates in ongoing learning of new simulation technologies.
- Assist in maintenance of policy and procedure manuals for simulation.
- May be assigned to perform other duties in the CCE during peak workload periods and in the absence of assigned personnel.

- Collaborates with the simulation coordinator, facilitator and CCE manager to resolve issues related to patient care scenarios.
