



Visiting Alverno

The safety and health of our team and guests are our top priorities. The Admissions Office asks guests to be familiar with the guidelines and practices below to ensure the health and safety of all.

Preparing for your visit:



Health Self-Assessment

Visitors should complete a health self-assessment before coming to campus. If you are experiencing any fever, cough, sore throat, have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19, or have traveled internationally in the 14 days before your visit, we ask that you please reschedule your visit. We recommend those who are at higher risk due to health concerns avoid coming to campus until the disease risk is reduced.



Personal Health Practices

- All guests should practice physical distancing by maintaining a minimum of 6 feet distance from other guests and staff.
- Please limit your party to three total people.
- **Please bring your own face covering and wear it when on campus - regardless of vaccination status.**
- Please sanitize your hands upon arrival and throughout your visit at one of our sanitizer stations.



Arrival On Campus

- All visits are by appointment only. When you arrive, please enter the Sister Joel Read Center off of 43rd Street (large domed building) and your tour guide or admissions counselor will greet you there.
- We ask guests to arrive on time to their scheduled visit to ensure proper distancing during check in. If you will be late for your appointment, please contact the Admissions Office at 414-382-6100.
- Your visit will include a tour of campus and an appointment with an admissions counselor.

To Ensure Your Safety

- All visit materials that you receive as part of your visit will be prepared in advance to minimize handling.
- All tour guides and staff will wear face coverings.
- Staff will be asked to stay home if they are not feeling well.
- Additional cleaning and sanitizing practices have been implemented across campus.
- We will provide a warm welcome but will limit close contact and handshaking.
