

# Women in Accounting SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Women in Accounting Scholarship Program recognizes a first-year student who plans to pursue an accounting degree as an undergraduate at Alverno College and plans to pursue her CPA license.

Recipients will receive up to \$25,000 a year towards their academic tuition each year for up to four years. To be considered eligible, applicants must complete the attached application form and meet all of the following criteria:

- Be admitted to Alverno College as a full-time student majoring in accounting for Fall 2020.
- Currently be a senior in any accredited high school.
- Maintain good academic standing and status as a full-time student at Alverno.

## **Application Process**

The following process must be completed to receive full consideration:

- Complete the Alverno College Application for Admission, which includes submitting your official high school transcripts and ACT or SAT score reports.
- Complete the FAFSA or submit an internal aid form.
- Complete the Women in Accounting Scholarship Application by Jan. 10, 2020.
- Submit a resume that includes work history, volunteer activities and any extracurricular activities.
- Submit two letters of recommendation to address the applicant's demonstrated accounting potential and abilities.
- A successful accountant is a person who is organized, numbers-oriented, eager to learn and loves a challenge. **In a two-page, double-spaced, 12-point-font essay, describe how you currently demonstrate all or some of these traits and how you will use your accounting degree from Alverno in your future.**
