Top Technology Tips for Students

Technology Use Policies

Usernames

Your username is the same for the campus network, IOL and Moodle. The protocol is the first six letters of your last name, your first and middle initial. Some may have a number if the username already exists. Example: the username for Susan B. Anthony would be **anthonsb NOTE:** Your username for Office 365 is your entire email address, e.g., anthonsb@alverno.edu. Your LiveText username is the one you created when you setup your account.

Office 365 Features

- Student email with personal calendar/contacts
- Teams video conferencing and
- OneDrive (cloud storage)
- Collaboration tools (share/edit files)
- Office Online to create Word, Excel, PowerPoint files (even without Office installed)
- Manage multiple email accounts and check email on your smartphone and/or tablet.
- Click the App Launcher icon all the features.

Microsoft 365 Student Email Basics

To look up an instructor's email address:

- 1. Click [⊕] New message; click **To button**
- 2. Click Default Global Address List (on left)
- 3. Enter a name in the search bar (Search Contacts) and press Enter
- 4. Click the + after the name to put it in the To section and click OK

To delete email messages:

Right-mouse click on the message and click **Delete.**

Passwords

Your Alverno network password must:

- ✓ Must be between 8-200 characters long
- ✓ Contain a combination of upper and lowercase letters;
- Include numbers and/or other special characters;
- ✓ Not be the same as any of your last five (5) passwords
- Also, please remember that passwords are cAsE- sensitive.
- Passwords must be changed every 180 days.
- Changing your network password WILL change your Wi-Fi, Office 365, Self-Service, and Moodle passwords. Your LiveText password is not synchronized with your network password.

Saving Files & Making Backup Copies

Make a backup copy of **ALL** your important work and **save it to more than one location**. Options for saving your files include:

- Your OneDrive cloud storage space through your Microsoft 365 account.
- Your Google Drive storage location
- Your own removable USB flash drive(s)
- Other personal cloud storage accounts (Dropbox, Google Drive, etc.).

NOTE: Do NOT save files to the hard drives on Alverno computers. The files will be erased by our security software when the computer is shut down or restarted.

Printing

- You will receive a 400-page printing balance at the beginning of each semester (Fall, Spring, Summer)
- Color prints use more print pages per page than noncolor printing.
- Install Mobility Print on a personal device which allows you to print to Alverno printers from anywhere.
- Additional pages may be purchased in the Computer Center, Library, or Media Hub at 10¢ (b/w) or \$1 (color) per page with a \$5.00 minimum purchase.

Open access computer labs are available for students in:

- The Computer Center in the Read Center (RC109B) and on the third floor of Christopher Hall (CH302)
- The Media Hub in the Read Center (RC114)
- The Library in Founders Hall (FO247)
 The Media Hub has a limited number of laptops available for checkout by Alverno students.
