This is a full time faculty exempt position. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications, education, and experience. Primary Duties and Responsibilities

The following information is not meant to be all-inclusive. Other duties and responsibilities may be assigned as necessary.

The Assistant Professor supports the Physician Assistant (PA) Program director through active participation in the following:

- Ongoing development, review and revision of the PA program mission statement.
- Active participation in the process of selection of applicants for admission to the PA program.
- Providing PA student instruction within the PA curriculum.
- Evaluation of PA student performance.
- Academic counseling of PA students.
- Assuring the availability of remedial instruction as needed to PA students.
- Ongoing curriculum design and evaluation with effective coordination and implementation of any curricular changes as needed.
- Ongoing PA program self-assessment and evaluation in collaboration with the dean, medical director, and principal faculty.
- Ongoing participation in program accreditation and maintenance of accreditation.
- Expected to attended program-related functions such as graduation, white coat ceremony, committee meetings, and activities vital to the program's success and continued accreditation.



- Teaching in areas of expertise as needed, skills instruction, participating in Summative Exam and OSCEs, participation in remediation as necessary.
- Engagement in teaching, scholarship and service activities
- Participate in PA Department committees
- Maintain clinical practice hours
- Participate in department meetings, committees, and official College functions when appropriate.
- Be respectful of the College's vision of a balanced and healthy lifestyle strategy, which includes the Seven Dimensions of Wellness: Career, Emotional, Environmental, Intellectual, Physical, Social, and Spiritual.
- Comply with safety procedures, including maintaining clean and orderly work areas.
