The students develop and implement effective creative arts plans, assume the professional role appropriate for undergraduate art therapy and directly practice interacting effectively in multiple contexts at a field placement site for the semester. In addition to observing and evaluating the student’s performance both on-site and in the classroom setting, the course instructor is responsible to provide weekly (in-class) supervision to address concerns, accomplishments, goals, and the students’ implementation of creative art processes at their field placement or practicum/internship site.

- Experience in providing clinical supervision is preferred
