Teach one course as described below:

ED 325: Literacy in Middle Childhood

The student examines the primary grade literacy curriculum, focusing on language, reading, writing, and literature. Among issues addressed are phonics, spelling, grammar, and sight and reading vocabulary. The student learns to make sound decisions, teaching literacy strategies, select appropriate materials, and design developmentally appropriate learning experiences and assessments for the middle childhood/primary grade learner.

- Knowledge of multiple instructional models and literacy assessments for 3rd 6th grade
- Reading Teacher License desired
- Ability to form positive relationships with students, faculty, and families
- Familiarity with the WI Foundations of Reading Test
