Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Research, evaluate, recommend, maintain, and support teaching and learning technologies.

Qualifications

- One to three years of work experience, preferably in a higher education setting.
- Experience providing technical training, and supporting technologies used in teaching and learning
- Experience with course management systems required; familiarity with Moodle preferred.
- Familiarity with ePortfolio systems and other learning technologies
- Experience using multimedia applications (such as Dreamweaver, InDesign Photoshop, Camtasia, SnagIt)



- Excellent interpersonal, oral, written, and web-based communication skills. Ability to communicate clearly, working with users, both individually and in groups.
- Demonstrated ability to research, analyze, and interpret technical information and explain it to users with varying technical knowledge
- Strong problem-solving skills including the ability to develop innovative approaches and ideas and meet challenges with resourcefulness
- Requires the ability to work independently as well as collaborate with others
- Requires the ability to work with and maintain confidential information
